## Dallas, Beaumont Swap 4-2 Victories

Aided by seven straight walks, the Beaumont Exporters score four times with two outs in the fourth inning en route to a 4-2 win over the Dallas Eagles in the first game of a Texas League doubleheader.

The four-run outburst snaps a string of 43 consecutive scoreless innings for Beaumont, which bettered the league mark of 36 which the Exporters had eclipsed the day before.

The streak comes to an end when Dallas' Rocky Contreras walks Pete Hernandez, the opposing pitcher, with the bases loaded, forcing in Pete Wotowicz.

Beaumont will go on to finish last in the eight-team Texas League with a record of 51-110, 42 1/2 games behind first place Dallas.
