With only one win in 14 decisions, 1910 was not a particularly good year for Brandon Angels' right-handed pitcher **Charles Earl**.

However, on the afternoon of May 25, Earl has his "One Shining Moment" when he out-duels future major leaguer Dave Skeels in a 3-2 win over visiting Moose Jaw.

Earl limits the visiting Robin Hoods to six hits while striking out two and walking one

In his next start nine days later (June 3) against Edmonton, Earl yields only eight hits in 11 innings, but drops a 2-1 decision to Edmonton ace Phil Dellar.

In two seasons (1909-1910) in the Western Canada League with Brandon, Earl is a combined 7-26, including a 6-13 mark in 1909.

The heady base running put up by the Angels was responsible for their win.
