Hagerstown Player Dies After Driving In Run

Hagerstown third baseman Raymond "Mac" Smith, a 23-year-old ex-Marine, dies en route to the Washington County Hospital after collapsing during a Piedmont (B) League game with the visiting Portsmouth Merrimacs.

In his final at bat, Smith has an RBI single in the fifth inning before collapsing at first base in front of 401 fans at Municipal Stadium.

The son of a minister in Chickamauga, Georgia, Smith's death is attributed to malaria and result-

ing complications that he contracted while serving in Korea, where he was awarded the Navy Star and two Purple Hearts.
