In a battle of second division teams, Columbus' third baseman [Hardin Herndon](#) goes 2-for-4, including his first home run of the year as the visiting Foxes push across five runs in the last two innings to key an 8-2 win over Macon.

Herndon, a 24-year-old native of [Summerville, Georgia](#), and the team's player/manager, also steals a base - one of his eventual league-leading 45 on the year.

Game umpire Ray Krebbs has an afternoon that he would probably like to forget, if he is able to remember it at all.

In the fifth inning, Krebbs is knocked out when he is struck in the head on a throw to the plate by Macon shortstop [Jimmy League](#).

After he is revived, the game continues with the players (mostly Macon's) complaining about his ball and strike calls.

It only gets better for the beleaguered Krebbs when in the eighth inning when the Columbus bat boy picks up an errant throw and holds on to it while three Columbus runners to score. Most of the crowd leaves the park when the probably by now delirious arbiter allows all three runs to count.
