Barnhart Goes Deep

REDS DEFEAT PIRATES IN 13 INNINGS

Pittsburg Pirates third baseman Clyde Barnhart hits a ninth inning home run off Cincinnati Reds lefty Eppa Rixey to tie the game at 3-3. Cincinnati would eventually win the Sunday afternoon contest 4-3 in 13 innings, handing the first-place Pirates only their 10th loss in 36 games.

Barnhart's game-tying home run turns out to be the only one that Rixey will allow that season in 301 innings of work.

The 25-year-old Barnhart's hit to right field goes under a roll of canvas where it is retrieved by a boy who flees with the ball while Barnhart happily circles the bases.

A native of Buck Valley, Pa., Barnhart finishes 1921 with three home runs and 62 RBIs while the 30-year-old Rixey posts a 19-18 record with 2.78 ERA. A University of Virginia graduate and a 1963 Hall of Fame inductee, Rixey wins 266 games in 21 seasons and allows only 93 home runs in 4,492 and 2/3 innings.

Cincinnati, O., May 30.—Pittsburg was defeated by Cincinnati in a 13 inning game. The ninth inning was featured by a freak home run when Barnhart's hit into right field went under a roll of canvas. The ball was recovered by a boy who fled with it and the hit went for a homer. Score:
