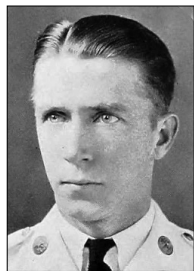


On This Date

July 11, 1943

In the second game of a Piedmont (B) League doubleheader, Lynchburg's 41-year-old right-hander [James Bond](#) out-duels future major leaguer [Al Sima](#), pitching a one-hit shutout in a 3-0 win over the homestanding Richmond Colts.

Bond, a three-sport athlete at Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College and Polytechnic Institute (now Virginia Tech) from 1923 to 1926, strikes out two and walks one in picking up his fourth win of the season.



On the year, the Driver, Virginia, native will finish 6-5 with nine complete games and a 2.41 ERA as Lynchburg finishes fifth

in the Piedmont League with a 54-74 mark.

Bond's catcher in that second game is [Alvin Kluttz](#), brother of Catawba College alum and major league catcher Clyde Kluttz.
